Our fabrics comply strictly with the UV Standard 801, a method of analysis to determine the UPF (Ultraviolet Protection Factor). When it comes to awnings, the fabric strength, aging under sun, rain, humidity and other weather conditions, reduces the capacity of the fabric to UV Protection.

Consequently, these factors should be taken into account when fabric is tested to give a reliable UPF factor to avoid any risks for end-users.

Consumer Information

RECacril® fabrics are high-performance fabrics made out of a solution dyed acrylic fibre. The Infinity finish provides the fabric an exceptional water and dirt repellent performance, resulting in a durable fabric that maintains its appearance throughout its life.

However, during installation of the awning some imperfections may occur. These small irregularities such as wrinkles, folds, crazing and veining are inherent in the nature of acrylic fibre and have no effect on the performance or qualities of the fabric. Therefore, it is neither the fabric manufacturer's nor installer's fault, and replacement is not necessary.

Subsequent to handling, small white traces may appear on acrylic fabrics treated with resins containing fluoride. Crazing and Veining are particularly visible on light-coloured fabrics when inspected against the light. These traces will dissipate over time. When rolling the fabric, folds may occur in the centre or along the stitching.

Maintenance of RECacril®

The high-tech finish of the Infinity process gives RECacril® fabric a lasting protection against fungi and excellent water on oil repellency, protecting you from both the sun and water for many years. However, dust accumulation, particles of air pollution, foreign organic matter and dirt in general, can damage this protection shortening the life of the fabric and therefore must be eliminated.

The most effective method of maintenance is to clean the fabric once a month with a hose with light pressure, this prevents accumulation and penetration of dirt in the fabric. It is very important that after cleaning with water let the canvas completely dry before rolling up the awning.

In case of rain, the awning can be left extended, since the rain helps rinse away the dirt. If for any reason the wet awning must be rolled up, unroll it as soon as possible and let it dry completely. In time of continuous rains and strong weather it is advisable to keep the awnings rolled up. In this periodic cleaning with water is performed, in most environments, it will only be necessary to do a deeper cleaning process every 2 or 3 years.





Terms and Conditions and E&OE apply

RECacril® Warranty

Recasens guarantees the RECacril® canvas for a period of 7 years from the date of installation. The guarantee covers the abnormal deterioration, decay and loss of colour of RECacril® subjected to normal atmospheric conditions and when correct maintenance has been systematically carried out. Within the period, Recasens will replace free of charge the defective yardage or pay its cost. The guarantee covers only the value of the canvas and specifically excludes any other elements of the awning (hardware, mechanisms, etc.), as well as the costs of producing and installing the awning. The warranty does not cover any deterioration due to abuse, negligence, vandalism, burns of any kind, fires and natural disasters.

In particular:

- The lack of maintenance of the canvas during its use in products or instruments. In particular, NEVER use solvents of hard brushes or other scraping instruments that can damage the protective finish of the canvas.
- Atmospheric pollution or plant herbicides.
- Animal Waste.
- Mounting defects or misuse by the user.
- Placing objects on top of the canvas, or falling objects on it.
- Unusual atmospheric conditions (lightning, storms, etc.)

In order to process the guarantee, it is necessary to contact the installer or distributor from whom you purchased the product. The installer or distributor shall forward the claim to Recasens. Replacement or refund of defective fabric does not imply the extension of the warranty of the replacement fabric.
